

Kristaps Ancāns, born in 1990, is an artist and educator whose practice focuses on installation, sculpture, text, and AR. In his explorations, he immerses himself in crafting the intricate relationships among human-kind, material nature, and machines through a conceptual game while looking at the obvious connections between art and science across history as collaborating agencies, examining the form and structure of the elemental building blocks from which material or augmented reality could be created. The significance of language and its materiality is intrinsic to his practice. Ancāns is an initiator and co-founder of POST, an interdisciplinary MA program at the Art Academy of Latvia. He currently divides his time between London and the Latgale region.

Ancāns has exhibited, lectured, and taught at venues internationally, including Times Square Arts, Das Weisse Haus, apex art NY, Publek/ Park S.M.A.K Museum, The Latvian National Opera and Ballet, Riga International Biennale of Contemporary Art, Code Art Fair Copenhagen, domobaal, Tate Exchange/Tate Modern, Museum of London, Royal Academy of Arts London, Central Saint Martins/UAL, PEER, Vienna Contemporary, Estonian Academy of Arts, Tallinn Art Hall, Setouchi Triennale, Tokyo University of the Arts. Artist is part of Beyond Matter project (ZKM, Centre Pompidou Tirana Art Lab, Tallinn Art Hall, Aalto University, Ludwig Museum).

He was awarded the Cecil Lewis Sculpture Scholarship (UK), and his works are included in various public and private collections, including the Latvian National Museum of Art (LVM) and the Brunswick Group (London), among others. He received the Helen Scott Lidgett Studio Award 2016/2017 (UK) and the Pauls Puzinas Grant (LV/USA), and was nominated for the Purvītis Prize (LV) and the Arts Foundation Fellowship (UK).
